# NOMINATION FOR THE SCOUTING AMERICA COUNCIL ALUMNUS OF THE YEAR AWARD



The Scouting America Council Alumnus of the Year Award is Scouting Alumni's highest recognition for service to the alumni effort at the council level. The award was established to recognize alumni of Scouting America who, over a sustained period of time, have used the skills and values they learned through their association with Scouting to make significant and long-lasting contributions to their local communities through their efforts toward strengthening Scouting through the Alumni programs.

A Scouting America alumni includes anyone positively and personally impacted by Scouting America former Scouts, family members of Scouts past and present, community leaders, and the millions of Americans who benefit from Scouting in their communities everyday.

The Alumnus of the Year features two symbols. The first is the Campfire encircled by 12 stones. This was picked as the symbol of Scouting Alumni because around a campfire, there are no strangers. A campfire calls us to gather, connects us to one another, and leads us to build and share our community. Today, a Scout campfire continues to be a place where friendships form, songs are sung, laughter is shared, and lessons are learned. Stories and skits are told and retold, as they have been by generations of America's young people.

An acorn, the second symbol of Scouting America's Alumnus of the Year awards, is a reminder that tiny seeds planted along the Scouting trail will eventually cultivate and grow into extraordinary trees under which those who planted often never sit. From little acorns, mighty oaks grow.

Note: This award is not a person-of-the-year award, general lifetime achievement award, or a different version of the Silver Beaver Award. It is to recognize significant alumni effort at the council level.

#### **Nomination and Selection Process**

Nominations should be submitted to the local council's Alumni committee. Each council committee will select their own method and timeline for selecting their Council Alumnus of the Year. The council is allowed a maximum of one Alumnus of the Year per calendar year. The selection committee should consider the Alumni effort as eighty percent and the community / professional effort as twenty percent of the overall selection process.

Before a Council alumnus of the year may be notified, the application must be submitted to the national Scouting Alumni to ensure that the nomination does not exceed the council's quota of one recipient per year. Submissions need to be electronically submitted to scouting.alumni@scouting.org. The national awards and recognition subcommittee will review the nomination. Once the Council receives confirmation from the Scouting Alumni that their nominee has been recorded, the Honoree may be notified, and a suitable recognition ceremony should be planned.

#### **Award Presentation and Recognition**

The Council Alumnus of the Year Award presentation should be conducted with the highest level of honor. Often, these individuals have lent their influence through their positions in their profession, avocation, and community to support Scouting. Each recipient should receive recognition worthy of the service rendered on Scouting's behalf.

The personalized certificate will be returned to the Council once the Award has been approved by Scouting Alumni. Other recognition items are available through the National Supply Peer to Peer network. Items available are: medallion (No. 621294), lapel pin (No. 621089), and knot device (No. 657423) to affix to the Alumni Award knot (if the recipient has earned the Alumni Award).
